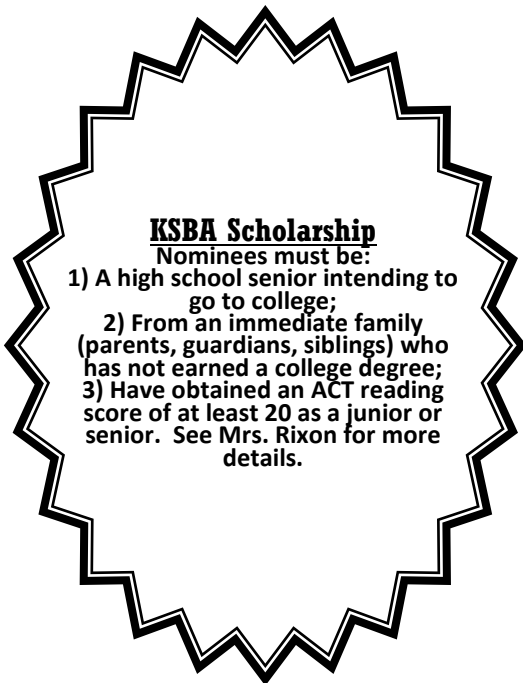

Important Dates

- September 22nd (8:00 a.m.—10:00 a.m.)—Senior Picture Make-up Day.** This is the LAST chance to get your picture in the yearbook.
- September 23rd (9:30 a.m.—2:15 p.m.)—College Fair at Lindsey Wilson College.** We had 95 seniors sign up to attend. Permission slips are ready to be picked up from Mrs. Rixon. They must be returned no later than Friday, September 19. Please be aware that they must have it signed and turned back in to me to attend.
- September 30th (9:00 a.m.)—Northern Kentucky University President** will be here to give a presentation to interested students. His presentation is not just about the university, but also about the importance of post-secondary education. I will have a sign-up sheet in my room soon for interested seniors.
- October 27th (12:00-1:00)—Senior Presentation at ANC—Seniors** will go to the auditorium to receive a presentation from our KHEAA representative, Audrey Fowler. Her presentation will cover a Getting In book for the class of 2015, an overview of financial aid, and a preview of College Application Week.
- October 27th (6:00 p.m.-7:00 p.m.)—FAFSA PREP NIGHT for PARENTS—Parents and guardians of seniors** are invited to attend a FAFSA PREP NIGHT event at the ANC. Audrey Fowler, our KHEAA representative, will discuss different types of financial aid, KEES money, college admissions, and other items pertaining to the class of 2015. This will be a very informative meeting to know what to expect in terms of the FAFSA completion.
- October 31st (during the day)—Somerset Community College Preview Day—Seniors** will sign up at a later date to attend this event that will be held at the Vocational School and at the ANC during the school day. Students interested in going to Somerset Community College will benefit from this event. SCC will bring admissions counselors, professors, program reps, financial aid reps, etc.
- November 10th—National Honor Society Induction Ceremony/Breakfast.** NHS MEMBERS ONLY. Students have already been notified if they are members of the National Honor Society. Students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.7 or higher. This breakfast will be for the students and their parents.

At a minimum, applicants must:

- Plan to graduate from a US high school in spring 2015
- Intend to enroll in an accredited four-year college beginning in fall 2015
- Earn a cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.5 or above
- Receive standardized test scores in the top 15%: SAT combined critical reading and math score of 1200 or above and/or **ACT composite score of 26 or above**
- Demonstrate significant unmet financial need. We will consider applicants with family income up to \$95,000. However, we anticipate that a majority of scholarship recipients will be eligible to receive a Pell grant

ASVAB: 50 or above

WorkKeys: Silver Certificate or above

KOSSA: pass with a 70 or higher to earn KOSSA Certificate
